Special Issue "Peruvian Conference on Scientific Computing"

This special issue contains nine contributions of the "Peruvian Conference on Scientific Computing", which was held from October 3 to October 6, 2022, in the beautiful city of Cusco, Peru.

The objective of this conference was to bring together Peruvian and international researchers working in the area of scientific computing, in particular in the fields modeling, simulation and optimization with differential equations. A focus was on topics that are of particular interest for researchers in South America, such as subsurface flows, mathematical epidemiology, climate and environmental research and computational fluid dynamics. PeC³ is a network of universities and scientists from Peru and Germany with the goal to foster research and education in scientific computing, applied and computational mathematics.
